

VET Applied Language

Overview

Since 2009, Ripponlea Institute has been delivering two accredited qualifications as VET delivered to secondary school students (i.e. VET in Schools) programs. The qualifications are:

- 10949NAT Certificate II in Applied Language
- 10661NAT Certificate III in Applied Language

The qualifications are nationally recognised, and are aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR), and the International Second Language Proficiency Rating (ISLPR). *The qualifications are not Language specific and are suitable for delivery in any script or character based Language.*

Course Entry Requirement and Prerequisites

Ripponlea Institute requires that students undertaking the Certificate II in Applied Language would have previously studied the target Language for at least one year.

It should also be noted that the successful completion of the Certificate II in Applied Language is an entry requirement for the Certificate III in Applied Language.

There are also opportunities for students who are native speakers, or who have completed studies in Languages at senior Certificate of Education level, to complete an assessment-only pathway.

Suggested Classroom Hours

The allocation of sufficient face-to-face class time is critical to ensuring that the course outcomes are able to be achieved by students. Ripponlea Institute requires students to have completed at least one year of study in the target Language, before enrolling in the Certificate II. The recommended minimum allocation of class time is as follows:

Certificate II – 2 hours per week

Certificate III - 2.5 hours per week

Structured Workplace Learning

Structured Workplace Learning (SWL) is not a requirement for this program. However, Ripponlea Institute strongly recommends that students undertake a minimum of five days SWL for each year of their VET Applied Language program. SWL should be spread across the duration of the training program.

Contribution to Senior Certificate of Education, and Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR)

The VET Certificates II and III in Applied Language may contribute to meeting the student eligibility requirements for their senior Certificate of Education. The VET qualifications may also contribute to the calculation of the university aggregate and Australian Tertiary Admission Rank (ATAR). These arrangements will vary between States/Territories, and schools must consult with their local education and/or training authorities.
